



Think-ets for On the Go Imaginative Play

Are you ever in a situation where you are waiting for something or someone - at the doctor's office or on a plane, perhaps? Turn waiting into fun and imaginative play with **Think-Ets**, a tiny toy that can fit in a purse, briefcase, or carry-on bag.

Think-Ets is a small bag filled with tiny trinkets, such as a mini block, book, and ring. While the amount of games to play are endless, the bag comes with directions for several different games, such as "what's missing" where one player lays out 5 or more trinkets, while the others memorize them. Then, a piece is removed and the other players have to guess what is missing. There are many other games to play, and you'll find the time just flying by.



While the games are fun, an even better reason to buy from this company is how conscious they are of the world. The games are assembled by SHALOM Denver, which provides employment to people with disabilities. Rather than use cheap plastic pieces, each piece is sourced from a unique place. For example, there are pieces from Mexico made under fair labor conditions, pieces from Germany, hand-painted phthalate free resin animals, and lead-free "tools" that really work! Finally, a toy that engages your mind, uses minimal packaging, and is environmentally and socially conscious!
